- Connecticut False Claims Act ("CT FCA").
- All providers must follow the "CT FCA" Connecticut General Statutes Chapter 55e- Section §4-274 through §4-289. The C.G.S section §4-275 False claims and other prohibit acts regarding state-administered health or human services program refers to individuals who present a false or fraudulent claim for payment or approval (e.g. double billing; billing for services not being provided; billing for excessive or unnecessary services, etc.). Note: Definition C.G.S. §4-274(1) - An act is also done "knowingly" if the Individual: a) Acts is deliberate ignorance of the truth or falsity of information or; b) Acts in reckless disregard to the truth or falsity, regardless of whether the person intends to defraud. Any person who violates this provision shall be liable to the state. The Attorney General may investigate any violation of the C.G.S. Section §4-275 (a).
