KEY FACTS ABOUT MSP

MSP Embedded Clinicians are:

- Civilian Clinicians who have answered the call to serve Citizen Soldiers and their families
- Licensed Psychologists (Psy.D), Clinical Social Workers (LCSW), Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFT), Licensed Substance Abuse Counselors (LADC), and Licensed Counselors (LPC)
- Familiar with deployment health issues and the stresses common among military service members and their families.





MSP Embedded Clinicians provide:

- Individual counseling on the site during drill weekends
- Workshops to Unit members on topics relating to behavioral health (substance abuse, depression, anxiety, PTSD, anger, marriage and family issues)
- Clinicians ARE civilians, and are funded by the Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services through the military Support program (MSP)

Military Support Program CONFIDENTIALITY POLICY

All services provided through MSP are confidential. We recognize that this is critically important to Service Members who may be concerned about their personal health information being divulged to personnel within the National Guard or Reserves. Because MSP is organized and designed to operate separately from the National Guard and the Reserves, we can provide Service Members and their families the highest quality of care without the concerns about confidentiality. It is the policy of MSP that a Service Member's or Family Member's personal health information will not be communicated to any other person or agency without informed, written consent.
